

We are leading the charge to decarbonize New York's buildings.

- In collaboration with the NY Building Decarbonization Coalition and labor unions, we secured passage of a first-in-the-nation utility decarbonization bill: the Utility Thermal Energy Network and Jobs Act. The bill will preserve and create good union jobs that will decarbonize buildings at a neighborhood scale and remove barriers that were blocking implementation of New York's climate law
- Our collaboration with partners in the Renewable Heat Now and Better Buildings NY Campaigns secured the Governor's commitment to 2 million climate-friendly homes by 2030



We are decarbonizing homes and using this hands-on experience to shape policy.

- Through our Solarize and HeatSmart campaigns, we've worked hand-in-hand with local partners to help over 500 households install solar, heat pumps, and energy efficiency measures, preventing over 20 million pounds of carbon emissions
- Based on this experience, we've built powerful advocacy campaigns that have opened up access to solar energy for low-income households and were instrumental in securing over \$454 million in rebates for renewable heating

As part of the NY Energy Democracy Alliance, we co-led a collaborative process with NYSERDA that secured a \$52 million commitment to create 12 regional clean energy hubs across the state

We are advocating for ratepayers by standing up to the fossil fuel and nuclear energy industries.

- Our rate case organizing has kept utility bill hikes in check, helped local communities cancel four gas pipelines and millions of dekatherms of gas sales, and advanced non-gas alternatives for heating
- We fought for and won \$15 million to be deposited into the Nine Mile Point Unit 2 decommissioning fund and clawed back \$20 million for Rochester-area consumers from the Ginna nuclear power plant

Our unique approach is key to our success: We are fiercely collaborative, and we get deep in the weeds.

- We've built relationships in solidarity with over 200 organizations and have activated 10,000 individuals across the state
- We co-founded four state-wide coalitions: the New York Energy Democracy Alliance, Renewable Heat Now, Better Buildings NY, and #UpgradeNY
- We are a go-to organization for information and support in understanding how New York's energy system works and how to improve it. And we've supported the climate movement with hundreds of workshops and teach-ins across the state
